Rick is remembered as much for his work at Peoples Trust as for his individual contributions to the people of Franklin County. He was admired personally and professionally. His name is synonymous with community service and commitment; we will never forget his ambition to give more than he got. How do we ever recover from the loss of a true leader ~ we don't. But, we can honor others who exemplify his integrity, his commitment and his drive to serve the community.

This year's recipient holds true Rick Manahan's most treasured values: a solid understanding of love for community and love of family.

Hib Doe has been a part of the Vocational Rehabilitation team for over 20 years. So apparently both work family and home family get to share in that joy!

Hib Doe, your endearing personality, your steadfast leadership, and your unending commitment to community and family has had an incredible impact on our region and in our state. We are sincerely grateful and the lives of our peoples are forever better.
