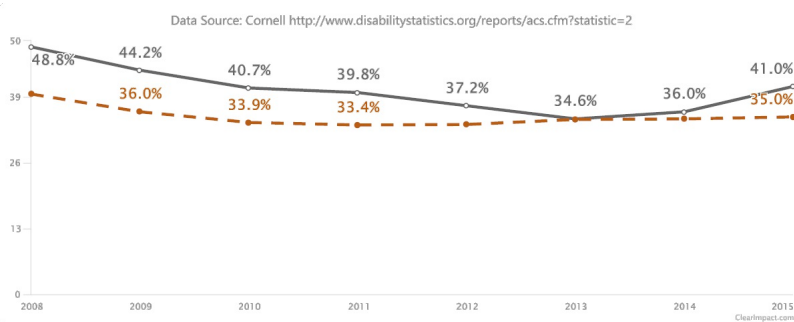

I Act 186 Estimated employment rate of Vermonters age 21-64 with all disabilities



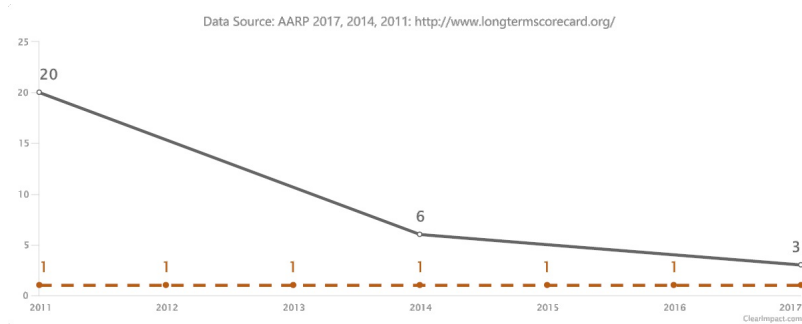

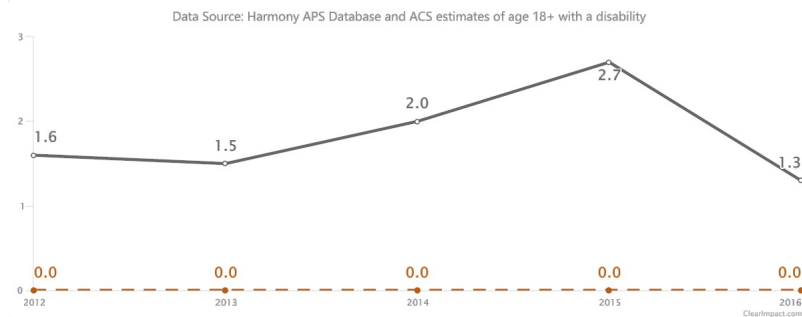

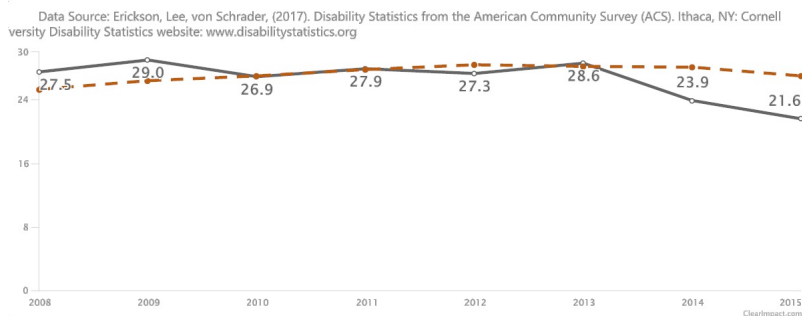

I DLP Rate of confirmed reports of abuse, neglect and exploitation of vulnerable adults per 1,000 vulnerable adults



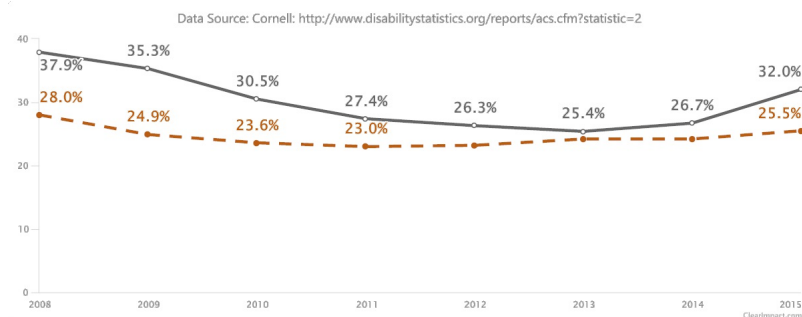

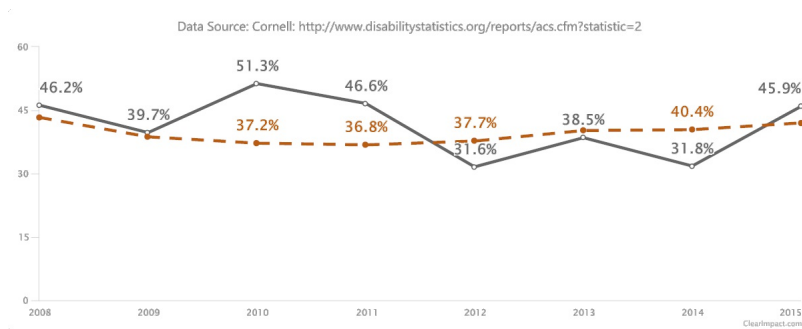

Estimated employment rate of Vermonters age 21-64 with visual disabilities

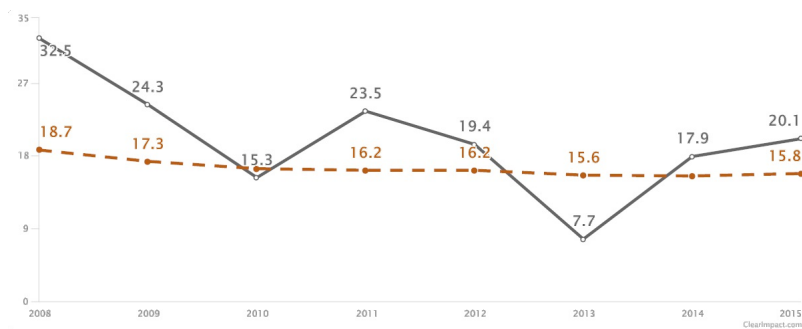

I VDH Older Adults % of adults age 65 and older who visited a doctor in the last year for routine care



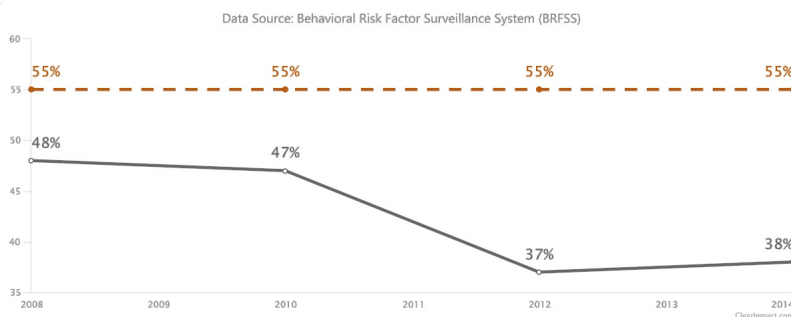

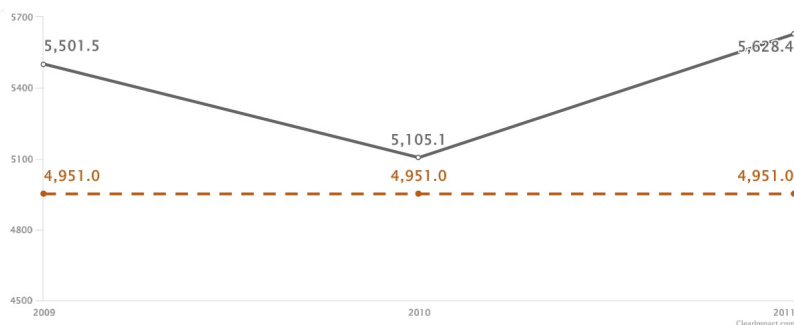
Fall-related emergency department visits per 100,000

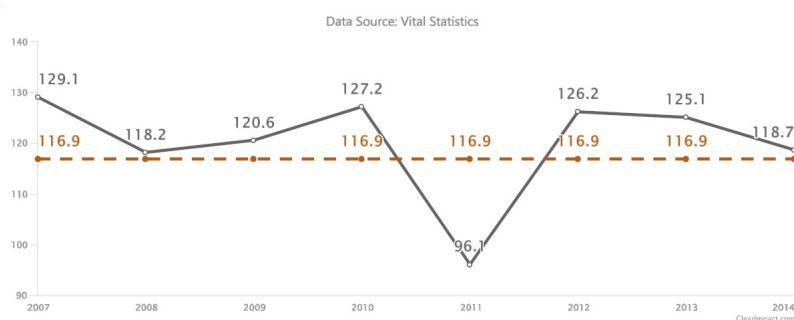

Fall-related death rate per 100,000 adults age 65 and older

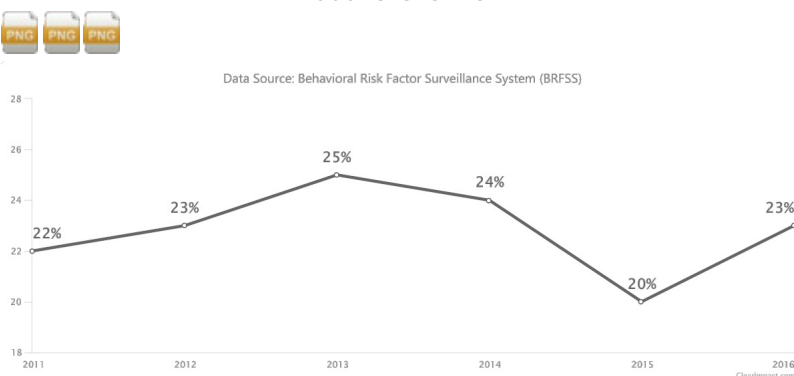

% of adults age 65 and older who drink at a level of risk

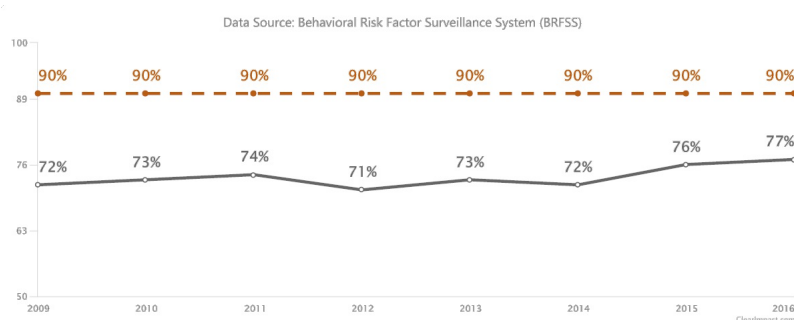

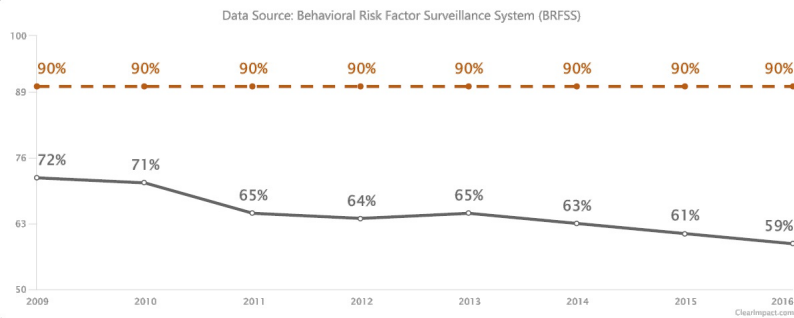

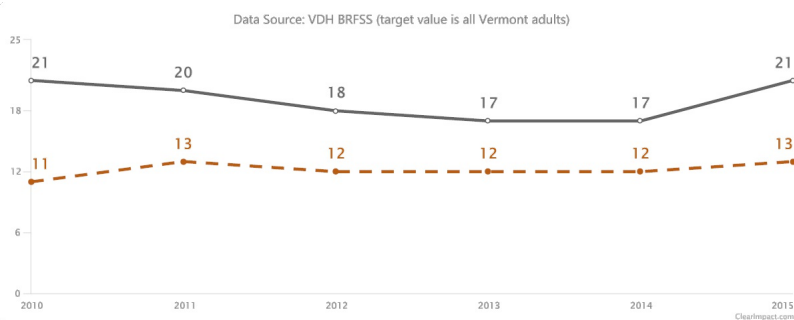

I VDH Immunization % of adults age 65 and older who receive annual flu shot



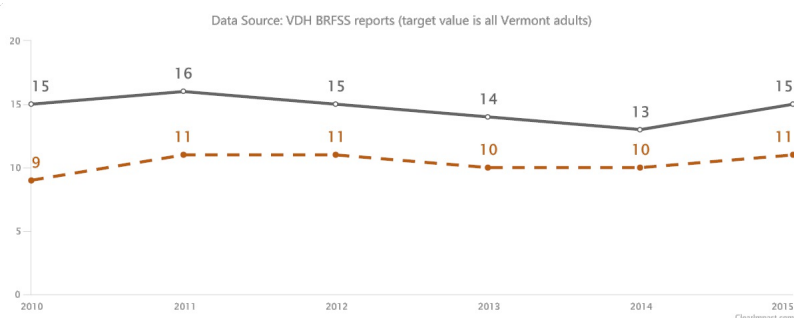

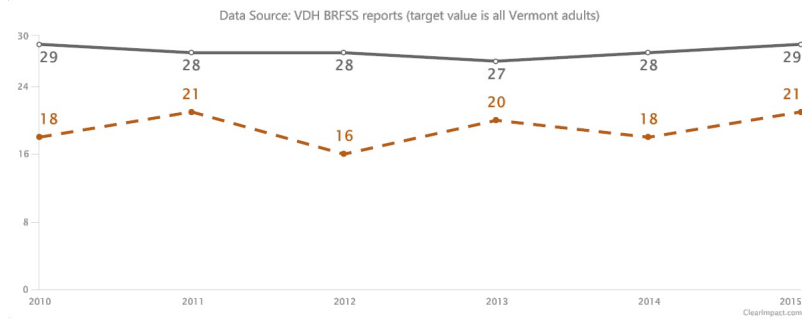

Percentage of Vermonters age 65+ who reported they did not participate in any leisure time physical activity during the previous month

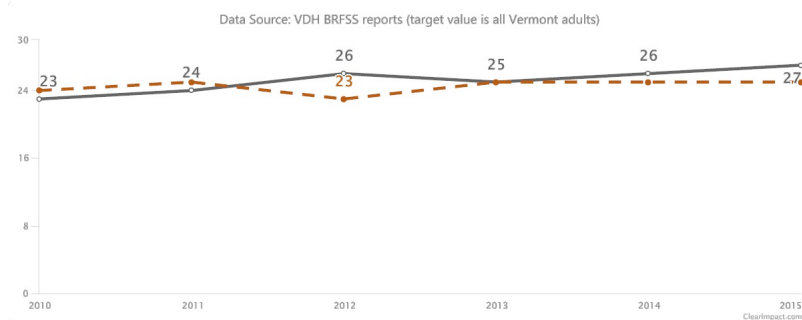

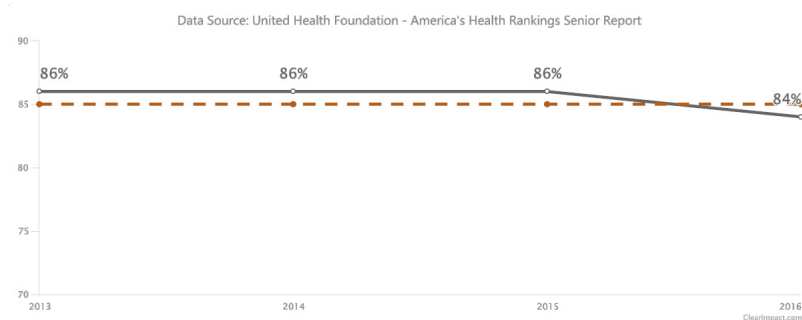

Act 186 Persons 60+ Living in Nursing Homes and Other Institutions as a % of All Persons 60+; Target Value is US rate

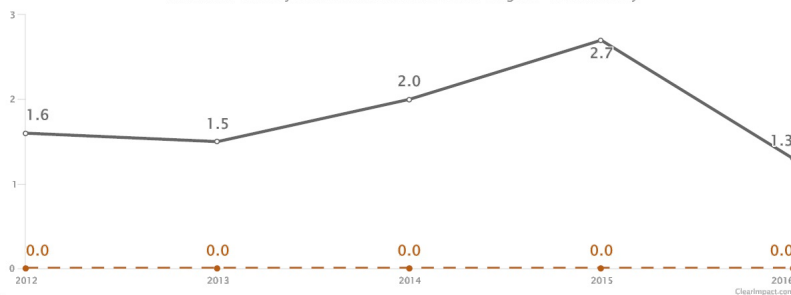

DLP Rate of confirmed reports of abuse, neglect and exploitation of vulnerable adults per 1,000 vulnerable adults

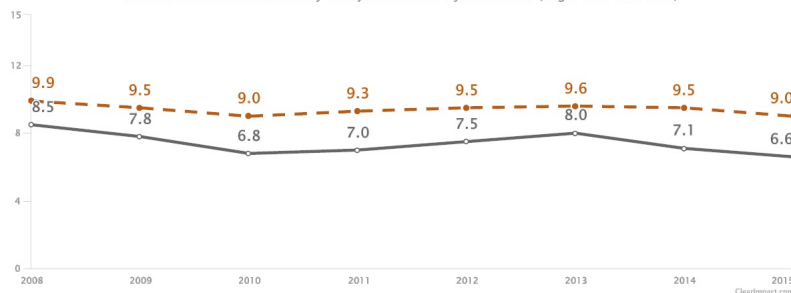

Older Adults Percentage of Vermonters age 65+ living in poverty

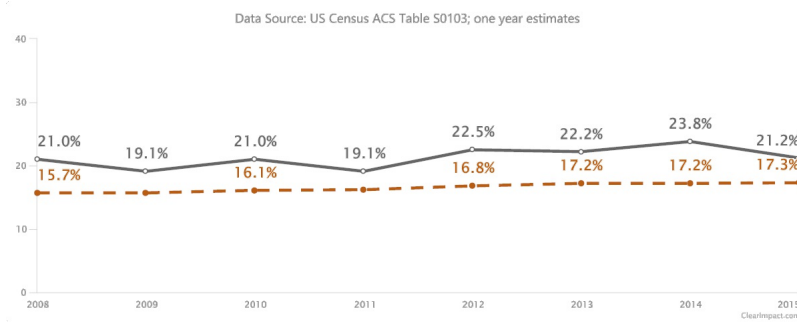

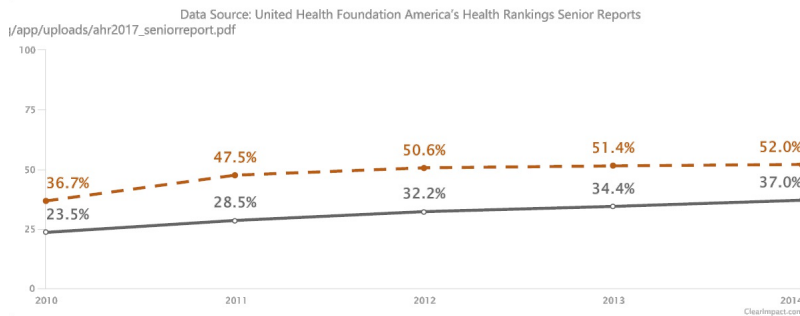
