Alerting devices

Alerting devices use a visual or vibrating alert to alert you to environmental sounds, such as a baby crying, doorbell, phone, security system, smoke/carbon monoxide alarm, phone, or weather.

Alarm clocks with loud ringers, flashing lights and/or vibration. Vibrating watches have timer functions that can be used in place of appliance timers (such as the oven, microwave, dryer, etc.).

Captioned phones

Captioned phones display captions of what the other caller says on a built-in screen (or app, if used on a smartphone). You can listen to the other caller and use your own voice to reply. Vermont Relay offers captions for English and Spanish.

Phone devices

Amplified phones have built-in volume control and clarity boosters.

Cell phone amplifiers use Bluetooth technology to send sound from your cellphone to your hearing aids, earphones, or a neck loop.

Ring signalers use blinking lights, vibrating device or loud ringers to alert a person that the phone is ringing.

TTYs (teletypewriters) are used to send and receive typed messages over the phone lines. A relay operator types the spoken message to the caller with the TTY and reads the typed message to the caller who does not have a TTY.

Videophones and Video Relay Services

Videophones are used to make phone calls in American Sign Language (ASL). Video Relay Services (VRS) provide ASL interpreters to interpret the call between ASL and English or Spanish. VRS apps are free for people who are D/deaf and Hard-of-hearing. Some vendors also provide stand-alone videophones. VRS requires high-speed internet.
