Meeting Minutes Overview

Picture in Picture (PIP) functionality involves placing the interpreter in the bottom corner of the screen, ensuring a consistent presence throughout the entire broadcast.



Live captions, regardless of content format (news, governor's broadcast, or emergency alerts), are consistently displayed at the bottom of the screen.

Appoint a designated state staff member responsible for ensuring the accessibility of emergency or disaster broadcasts for both D/HH individuals.

Create a petition for Vermont residents who are frustrated with the inconsistent information being broadcast, including incorrect or incomplete captions and obstructed views of Deaf ASL interpreters. The petition calls for improved and reliable access to news.

Assign an Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) point person to guarantee that all processes are accessible to state employees and the public.

Proposal

Establish a point of contact within the Vermont Emergency Management Team who possesses the necessary knowledge to obtain or set up captioners and ASL interpreters for broadcasts by news channels, the governor, and other relevant entities.
