Re: *Licensing and Operating Regulations for Therapeutic Community Residences;* Agency of Human Services, Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent Living (DAIL)

Dear Ms. Corliss,

Attached please find a proposed amendment to the existing *Licensing and Operating Regulations for Therapeutic Community Residences*. The proposed rule makes technical corrections, as well as substantive changes to address the following:

During the Serious Mental Illness/Institutions for Mental Disease (SMI/IMD) waiver negotiations with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), CMS outlined milestones that Vermont needed to meet. Within Milestone 2 is a state requirement to ensure psychiatric hospitals and residential settings contact beneficiaries and community-based providers, through the most effective means possible (e.g., email, text, or phone call), within 72 hours of discharge. Vermont is meeting this requirement by incorporating it into administrative rule.

The Interagency Committee on Administrative Rules (ICAR) reviewed and approved the proposed rule during its meeting on August 17, 2021, subject to the Department making the recommended changes detailed in the minutes from that meeting. Those changes have been made.
