Timeframe	Activity
October 2021 – January 2024	Advisory Committee Meetings
2022-2023	Statewide Assessment of Aging Well: Survey, Listening Sessions, Focus Groups, Data Collection
2023	Development of Age Strong VT Plan
November 2023	Launch of Draft Plan; Public Comment Period; Age Strong VT Summit
January/February 2024	Finalized Plan; Approved by Advisory Committee; Age Strong VT Resolution at Statehouse

# Next Steps

1. Continue to raise awareness about the plan; leverage plan to elevate important issues.
1. Continue to seek resources for this work.
2. Develop data dashboard to track progress on outcomes.
3. Create Implementation Structure/Plan:
  - How will we implement such a large and comprehensive plan with limited resources? What implementation structures will help us move forward?
  - How will oversight be provided ongoing? What sort of advisory capacity is needed?
  - How do we continue to engage the public and a broad range of stakeholders across many sectors?
