Re: Adult Day Operations

On Friday November 13, 2020 Governor Scott issued [Addendum 8 of Executive Order No 01-20](#) which extends the State of Emergency through December 15, 2020. The order also recognizes the recent surge in COVID-19 cases and institutes an “appropriate return to more limited standards of operation and social gatherings in order to control outbreaks of COVID-19”.

Based on the recent Executive Order and after consultation with the Vermont Department of Health, **AHS and DAIL recommend that Adult Day Programs suspend in-person programs for now.** We recognize how much work you have done to prepare for reopening and that families and individuals are counting on you. And yet our ultimate goal is to protect the health of Vermonters, including your participants and staff.
