- UMMS sought to establish data demographics and projections on a statewide and county level
- The standard definitions in the Census data were deemed too broad for the project purpose, so we sought to refine the definition of disability
  - Required custom data request from Census Bureau
- The custom definition resulted in contracting delays between the Census Bureau, Vermont, and UMMS, so there was a delay in completing the project

# Data *(continued)*

---

## Standard definition of “disability”

- Census uses a very broad set of categories for “disability”
- Each category almost certainly includes individuals needing LTSS; however most have the potential to include those who do not need LTSS
- To approximate the population needing LTSS, we used categories with individuals who need functional assistance with mobility, self-care or independent living



# Data *(continued)*

---

## Custom definition of “disability”

- Cognitive difficulty only (difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions)
- Functional difficulties only (difficulty walking or climbing stairs; dressing or bathing; or doing errands alone)
- Both cognitive and functional difficulties
- Neither cognitive nor functional difficulties

- Census demographic data was limited by the definitions, but also by a methodology change
  - In 2008, the Census Bureau changed the definitions of fields related to disabilities, so we were limited in how long a baseline we could use
- Resolved many of these issues by relying on other data sources and making our assumptions very transparent
