### **PRE-TRIP SAFETY**

#### SCREEN:

- All riders screened with COVID-19 [Questionnaire](#)  
*\*Only Asymptomatic Riders will be scheduled \**  
We hope to coordinate with the agency to accomplish questionnaire
- All drivers screened prior to beginning their shift

#### PROVIDE:

- Cleaning protocols for drivers [CDC Cleaning & Disinfecting Vehicles](#)
- Proper PPE – gloved and masks
- Wipes & Sanitizer
- Masks / Face shields for passengers who do not have their own

### **TRIP SAFETY**

#### PROVIDE:

- Visual wellness check including mask or face shield
- Provide proper social distancing on vehicle
- Safe Wheelchair Securement [Wheelchair Securement](#)

### **UPON ARRIVAL**

- Temperature checks completed upon arrival by Adult Day provider
- Any symptoms upon arrival will prompt alternative transportation to medical care or home. The Adult Day provider will call 1-833-387-7200 (7:45 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., M-F). The VPTA will secure appropriate ambulance services that will transport the individual.
