

SHIFT OF VR TRANSITION PROGRAM "TRANSITION OF TRANSITION"

- > Transition Counselors: In transition to now serve youth 14 through 24 years old (Transition of Transition); manages referrals and relationships with high schools; the "hub".
- > Youth Employment Specialists: Paired 1:1 with Transition Counselor to serve the same students; WBL/Work readiness activities.
- Business Account Manager: Establish and maintain employer relationships; facilitates Creative Workforce Solutions meetings that pulls together all partners connecting with the business community.
- Depending upon student, may also include Job Coach and/or Benefits Counselor

GOALS OF TRANSITION OF TRANSITION

- > To facilitate a positive transition to adult life for youth (and families) through consistency in staff providing services.
- >To increase the number of students receiving Pre-Employment Transition Services.
- >To increase the number of students who continue working with VR post-graduation or upon leaving school.
- >To expand and enhance our collaboration with high school and career center teams.

PROGRAM SHIFT PROVIDES MORE WAYS TO PARTNER

- Increase the connection between school employment coordinators/work-based learning coordinators and Creative Workforce Solutions/Business Account Managers.
- Increase the connections between VR staff and the school guidance counselors, especially in referring students on 504s and around post-secondary exploration/support.
- > Enhance relationships with families as they navigate services for youth outside of high school.
- Increase/enhance collaboration via Core Transition Teams to ensure that students engage, imagine, and achieve their career goals.

VR SUMMER CAREER EXPLORATION PROGRAM

- > Serves HS students statewide, ages 14 through 21 (including students graduating in June 2021) on an IEP or 504
- > 249 students with disabilities, who demonstrate very diverse levels of skills and abilities, applied for the program.
- > Students statewide will engage in work site training opportunities to explore their top career interests at local businesses, while also learning work readiness skills in a classroom.
- Students will earn minimum wage for both the work and classroom components.
- > VR is committed to provide opportunities for all students who want to participate this summer, including an online *Introduction to College and Careers* course and virtual presentations on a range of careers.
- > Students have expressed interest in exploring careers like animal care, automotive technology, parks and recreation, and hospitality.

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT SPECIALIST (YES) IN SCHOOLS INITIATIVE

- Increase the number of students on IEPs and 504s receiving career exploration and work-based learning opportunities (helps meet transition plan goals)
- Increase the number of competitive employment or work-based learning experiences for students with disabilities prior to high school exit.
- Enhance School VR Partnerships (learn best practice)
- Link students to Vocational Rehabilitation early and establish the working relationship to reach beyond high school

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT SPECIALIST (YES) IN SCHOOLS INITIATIVE

- Collaborate with 4 high schools statewide that applied for the funding
- Provides a full-time youth employment specialist (YES) to implement Pre-Employment Transition Services:
 - Work-Based learning
 - > Word Readiness Skills
 - > Career Exploration
- Funding covers the position in full for the first two years, and then decreases to 50%, then 25%, for the third and fourth year.
- Priority given to schools that demonstrated sustainability plans.
- > Starts this upcoming 2021-2022 school year.
